

Kiverco & Anaconda think big

Kiverco T630

Mobile Screening & Crushing (MSC) recently delivered two new Kiverco T630 tracked mobile trommels to a customer in New Zealand. These machines run full electric operation, powered either off a detachable gen set of mains power (the tracks are electric/hydraulic drive). These machines feature an eight cubic-metre hopper capacity and a massive 30-by-six foot Trommel drum, and are available with an extended oversize conveyor and side folding fines

conveyor belts. They were designed for high output jobs while keeping in mind

ease of maintenance and efficiency by using all electric motors. Throughput rates at client sites have been recorded at over 150 TPH of fines product at 4mm aperture on palm kernel. The T630 can be used on any product where there is a need for high production while maintaining product quality. These include topsoil, compost, rock, sand etc. There is a range of optional extras available to suit clients' individual requirements. ■



Anaconda TD620 – new release

At the end of April Dan Meikle, product manager for MSC, visited the company's suppliers in Ireland to inspect new products and discuss new product development. One of these products is the new Anaconda TD620. After building the very successful TD516 Trommel, Anaconda has upped its game with not only a bigger machine, but also more features and machine adjustment to maximise production. Some of these features are a nine cubic-metre hopper capacity (with

extensions), 20-by-six foot Trommel drum dimensions, and power options of either diesel/hydraulic or electric/hydraulic drive (powered either off an on-board gen. set or

mains power). MSC has a machine on order, arriving in New Zealand around August. The Anaconda TD620 is also available as a stand-mounted static Trommel if required. ■



Anaconda J960 ECO JAW CRUSHER

The Anaconda range of mobile crushers has been designed with a real focus on cost savings and performance. For the contractor on the move the J960 would be a real asset. The J960 is a dual power model which runs at around five to six litres of fuel per hour and boasts arguably the quietest operating readings in the world. at 26 tonne. The wide range of features makes it one of the most user friendly crushers around. The robust design will produce a consistent rate of crushed product at up to 150T/hr.
